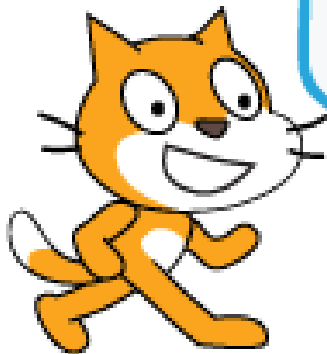


Coding with
